

£50 per term bursary towards new music lessons at West Berkshire primary schools

The Greenham Trust can offer financial support towards music lessons with Berkshire Maestros for children attending West Berkshire primary schools. Through the Greenham Trust Music Bursary Fund a £50 per term bursary may be offered (subject to availability of funds) on any group or individual lesson.

To qualify, your child must attend a West Berkshire primary school and must not be in receipt of the pupil premium or tax credits. **The offer is available to new students only and does not apply to existing Berkshire Maestros students.**

Please note that the bursary is funded until 2020 and has a ceiling of approximately 200 students. We will confirm if you have been successful in receiving a bursary.
