Covid-19 is an illness that can affect your lungs and airways. It is caused by a virus called Coronavirus. Symptoms can be mild, moderate, severe or fatal.

We are heavily minimising the risk of transmission of the virus, both airborne and surface, by adhering to the Government Education & Performing Arts guidance and have taken the measures outlined in the Risk Assessment below. Government guidance continues to be followed and the risk assessments will be reviewed and updated as and when required in relation to the Governments "Roadmap out of lockdown".

Rapid lateral flow tests help to find cases in people who may have no symptoms but are still infectious and can give the virus to others. All our teaching staff are requested to have regular Covid19 tests prior to face to face teaching in schools & music centres. Everyone over the age of 11 is required to wear a face mask/covering when moving around the building or waiting in communal areas.

Students can be dropped at the main entrance/reception area where they will be singed in, asked to use the hand sanitiser, have their temperature checked and advised which room/area they are in.</p> <p>Staggered start and finish times have been programmed to minimise the amount of people arriving and leaving areas at the same time and to allow for equipment to be cleaned.</p>	<p>New entrance and exit routes have been devised and a one-way system to ensure the “flow” inside Reading Music Centre.</p> <p>Yellow dots have been painted on the path leading to the music centre entrance.
